Mr. Picardi called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Appointments

7:15 pm.Appointment- George Collins- 85 South Street Mr. Collins explained the re[air to the Board. Jackson Macomber made a motion to grant the four feet to three feet to groundwater, Ralph Jensen seconded the motion. So voted unanimously. Mr.Macomber made a motion to grant fifteen feet to the SAS, Mr. Jensen seconded the motion. So voted unanimously. Mr. Macomber made a motion to accept the use of a sieve analysis Mr. Jensen seconded the motion. So voted unanimously. There are no sensitive receptors on site or nearby.
