Minutes

These are the minutes of the October 8, 2009 meeting of the Avon Board of Health. Members present were Gerald Picardi- Chair, and Ralph Jensen-Clerk.

Others Present: Jeanmarie Kent Joyce, Health Agent, David Klenert, Rob St. John, Eric Bazzett, James DiStefano, and William Self

Mr. Picardi called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Appointments

- 217 South Street- repair- Mr. Klenert explained the plans as submitted for repair. Mr. Jensen a motion to grant groundwater separation from 4 feet to 3 feet provided the 400” setback from the reservoir is maintained. Mr. Picardi seconded the motion, so voted.
- 64 Page Street- repair- Mr. Self reviewed the plans with the Board. Mr. Jensen made a motion to grant the use of a sieve analysis. Mr. Picardi seconded the motion. So voted.
- 15 Stockwell Drive- Mr. St. John and Mr. Biazzett discussed the plans for the proposed septic repair for the property. Mr. Jensen made a motion to sign the application provided 3 additional plans were submitted. Mr. Picardi seconded the motion, so voted
- 100 Wales Avenue -Tight Tank application – non-industrial holding tank for clean for septic waste from limo and buses. Mr. Jensen made a motion to approve the application provided a contract was received from a septic waste hauler to service the unit. Mr. Picardi second, so voted.

7:30 Installer’s Permit- Mr. James DiStefano came before the Board to discuss renewing his installer’s permit. Bill Self said that he was here as a friend of Mr. DiStefano’s. Mr. Picardi reviewed Mr. DiStefano’s past history and discussed receiving complaints regarding the work done and the extra costs incurred by the DePatras on 16 Johnston Road. Mr. Picardi also expressed his concerns regarding the length of time (five months) taken to complete the septic installation at 11 Tracey Drive and the numerous (twelve) inspections required for the job. Mr. DiStefano felt that it was not excessive for a system of this size. He also felt that the Board should automatically renew his permit because that is how it is done in other towns. Mr. Picardi suggested that the Board wait until a full Board was present at the next meeting. Mr. DiStefano indicated that he had the contract for 225 Bodwell Drive, had ordered the stock and it would be a hardship if he had to wait until a full Board was present. Mr. DiStafano and Mr. Self were reminded that by code, the Board has thirty days to act on an application once the completed permit application is received. Mr. Jensen requested that Mr. DiStefano not wait until he has a

job to renew his permit but that the permit is renewed in January when it is due. Mr. Picardi said that he would sign the permit due to the large investment and the weather concerns but that he would be watching carefully to make sure that the job went smoothly and with no issues. The installer's Permit was signed, a copy was made and the original given to Mr. DiStafano. Mr. DiStefano and Mr. Self left at 8:15 pm.

The Board acted on the issues:

1. Mr. Jensen made a motion to accept the minutes of the September 17, 2009 minutes. Mr. Picardi seconded the motion. So voted
2. The Board approved payments in the amount of \$ 16,309.15.
3. The Board was updated on H1N1 and seasonal Flu clinics.
4. Mr. Jensen made a motion to grant C. J.D. Contractors and K. Wells as installers in Avon. Mr. Picardi seconded the motion So voted.

Mr. Jensen made a motion to adjourn; Mr. Picardi seconded the motion; so vote.

The Board of Health adjourned at 8:35 PM.
