The Avon Board of Health has received a limited quantity of H1N1 flu vaccine. The vaccine is an injectable form (the shot) and contains thimerosal. Flu Mist is also available. *This clinic is by appointment only.* The clinic will be held 3 pm – 6 pm on Thursday, December 3, 2009 in the Avon Town Offices, 65 East Main Street. Avon, Ma. Documentation that you meet the criteria of the clinic is required. Preference will be given to pregnant women, children 6 months – 24 years old and adults 24-65 years old with chronic medical conditions. The Avon and Holbrook Boards of Health will hold a combined H1N1 flu vaccine clinic on Saturday, December 12, 2009 from 12 noon – 3PM at the Holbrook High School, South Franklin Street in Holbrook.

This clinic is for the following priority groups:

- *Pregnant women*
- *Household contacts and caregivers of infants younger than 6 months old*
- *Health care and emergency medical services personnel*
- *Infants, children, and young adults 2 years – 24 years old*
- *Adults 25 - 64 years old with the following conditions:*
 - *Pulmonary (including asthma)*
 - *Cardiovascular (except hypertension)*
 - *Renal, hepatic, hematologic, , or metabolic disorders (incl. diabetes mellitus)*
 - *Cognitive, neurologic or neuromuscular disorders, such as cerebral palsy, muscular dystrophy and developmental delays*
 - *Immunosuppression (incl. that caused by medications or by HIV)*
