*Not sure what is Hazardous, maybe this information will help you.  
Please make sure all chemicals are in the original or labeled containers.*

**From the workbench:** oil based paint and stains\*, hobby/artist supplies, photography chemicals, fiberglass resins and adhesives

**From the garage:** flammable liquids & aerosols, gasoline, motor oil mixtures, automotive fluids, tire's\*, carburetor cleaners, degreasers, marine & auto paints.

**From the shed:** pesticides, herbicides, fungicides, fertilizers containing pesticides, pool chemicals, cesspool cleaners and wood preservatives, propane tanks\*.

**From the house:** Mercury, including thermometers & thermostats\*, drain cleaners, moth balls & crystals, hazardous cleaners, polishers, poisons, acids and bases, electronics\*(fax machines, copiers, VCR's, DVD players, laptops, microwaves ,telephones ,ect), fluorescent tubes, compact fluorescents, rechargeable & button batteries, Monitors\* TV's\*.



## **Cost Items**

\* Commercial Painter with over 5 gallons of paint-\$5.00/gallon. Residents with over 5 gallons of

paint-\$1.00/gallon.  

\* Tires (with or without rims)-\$2.00 per tire, Truck- tires-\$8.00 per tire. 

\* Propane tanks \$6.00 each 

\* Monitors & TV's under 27"-\$10.00 over 27" \$20.00  

Latex paint & driveway sealer is **NOT** hazardous (just messy). Remove lid, air dry or absorb with cat litter or paint hardener and dispose with trash. Usable paint may also be donated.
