WHAT TO RECYCLE

HOW TO PREPARE

DO NOT INCLUDE

PAPER



- ▲ Newspapers/inserts
- ▲ Magazines, books and catalogs
- ▲ Junk mail
- ▲ Phone books
- ▲ Office paper

- ▲ Corrugated cardboard

- ▲ Chipboard (cereal and shoe boxes)

- ▲ Place all paper in paper bags
- ▲ Place beside or on top of bin
- ▲ Window envelopes, staples and paper clips are o.k.
- ▲ Cut, flatten and tie corrugated to 30"x 30" or smaller
- ▲ Place in bags with newspaper

- ▲ No food-soiled paper or boxes
- ▲ NO PLASTIC BAGS
- ▲ No waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- ▲ No wet paper

GLASS



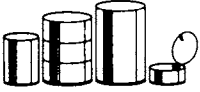
- ▲ Clear, green and brown food and beverage containers only

- ▲ RINSE CLEAN
- ▲ Collars & neck rings DO NOT have to be removed
- ▲ REMOVE lids & corks, etc.
- ▲ Paper labels may be left on

- ▲ No broken glass
- ▲ No other glass items such as window glass, Pyrex, ceramics, etc.

- ▲ No lightbulbs - bring fluorescent lightbulbs to HHW collection

METAL



- ▲ Deposit and non-deposit beverage cans
- ▲ Metal food cans
- ▲ Aluminum pie plates and trays

- ▲ RINSE CLEAN
- ▲ Crush to save space
- ▲ Labels may be left on

- ▲ No aluminum foil
- ▲ No paint cans
- ▲ No other metal items
- ▲ No aerosol cans
- ▲ No chain link fence

PLASTIC



- ▲ Plastic milk, juice or water jugs
- ▲ Soda bottles
- ▲ Detergent bottles
- ▲ All plastic containers

- ▲ RINSE CLEAN
- ▲ REMOVE LIDS
- ▲ Crush to save space

- ▲ NO PLASTIC BAGS
- ▲ No motor oil or chemical containers
- ▲ No unmarked containers
- ▲ NO STYROFOAM, packing peanuts or large pieces

RECYCLING COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Recycling bins are collected every week on your regular trash collection day.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day. Friday's collection will be on Saturday.

○ Holidays are marked with a circle. See calendar to right.

□ BULK COLLECTION DAYS - marked with a box. See calendar to right.

Bulky items, consisting of mattresses, box springs, furniture, large items, etc. are collected on the following Saturdays :July 21, September 22, November 10, January 26, March 29, May 17 (NO Construction Material)

BLUE=FIBER (Newspapers, Junk Mail, Corrugated etc.) BLACK = COMMINGLED (Metal, Glass, Plastics etc.)

AVON SOLID WASTE & RECYCLING PROGRAM
Residential Solid Waste Only. (No construction or commercial waste accepted)

- 1) Place all paper products in brown paper bags or tied in bundles. Separate from the trash to avoid confusion. Place all other recyclables in the bin provided.
- 2) If there are more recyclables than will fit in the container, place them in a suitable, clearly labeled receptacle which can be readily identified for the collectors.
- 3) Trash and recyclables must be placed at curbside before 7:00 a.m. on your regularly scheduled collection day.
- 4) If collector leaves items in the bin, it is because they are not recyclable. Please put them in your regular trash.
- 5) New homeowners should contact the Board of Health at 508-588-0414 to obtain a recycling bin.

Wheeled Totes for trash are available, Please call Howland Disposal Service @508-746-9600 to order.



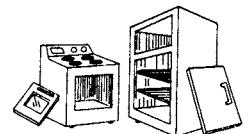
TELEVISIONS & COMPUTER MONITORS (CRTs)

NOTE #2: No Tires, Batteries, Paint or Automobile Parts allowed with the curbside collection. These are collected with special HHW collection. (Dropoff date to be announced)
